- Friday, April 14, 9:00am Friday Morning Knits @ Main Library -Rockport





How to Donate- Memory Books

Memorial gifts are accepted in honor or memory of a person(s). The SCPL Donation Form must be completed and submitted with each gift. Monetary donations are preferred so that new materials, which are useful to the library and desired by the community, may be acquired. Donors may specify the amount they wish to donate and may suggest a topic along with the type of material(s) they wish to be purchased. The library will try to honor all topic suggestions, but cannot guarantee the purchase of specific items. Gifts of physical materials must meet the same criteria as purchased materials for inclusion in the collection and are only accepted with the director's approval. A bookplate will be added to the item to honor or memorialize a person(s), and a card will be added to our honor/memorial file. Donors may request up to two (2) cards be sent to loved ones to notify them of the honored/memorial gift.
