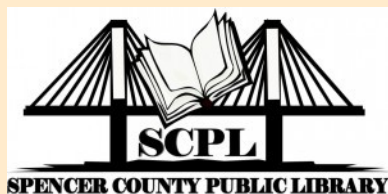

## NEW LIBRARY PROGRAMS

SCPL is proud to announce two new programs for the community. The first will begin this summer during SRP for the teens (ages 12-18) and is LEGO Mindstorms. The Mindstorm set is a programmable unit that controls motors and sensors as well as provides wireless communication (Wi-Fi and Bluetooth), essentially it's a robot! Teens this summer will practice building and coding these robots to perform specific tasks; interested teens should contact Kayla, 812-649-4866 to register for this weekly program. Look for more LEGO Mindstorms coming in the future for all ages!



The second new program is Boomwhackers!. Boomwhackers are musical instruments made from colorful plastic tubes. They can be played by simply "whacking" them or playing them with a mallet. SCPL staff will begin by teaching children the basics of music and how to have fun while playing! As children learn how to play the boomwhackers, mini concerts will be organized for public enjoyment!
