Ancestry.com Library Edition provides researchers with birth, marriage, & death records; along with military records; tax, criminal, land & will records; school directories & church histories. Ancestry.com Library Edition is perfect for the amateur genealogist or seasoned researcher.



Along with Ancestry.com Library Edition, SCPL now offers access to Fold3 Library Edition. Fold3 Library Edition specifically focuses on military records. It's a perfect resource for historians, researchers, Veterans, and genealogists. The name Fold3 comes from a traditional flag folding ceremony in which the third fold is made in honor and remembrance of veterans who served their country. Fold3 offers access to memorial pages, WWII draft registration cards, war records dating back to the Revolutionary War and as current as the most recent Iraq War; it even includes information regarding International Wars. Fold3 Library Edition is a wonderful resource to use when researching military records of all kinds or just a little family history.



Both of these great resources are available to all Spencer County residents. However, one can only access these databases from a public access computer or personal laptop connected to SCPL's WiFi, at our four SCPL locations. All SCPL locations offer public access computers with quick-links installed to access both databases. While a library card is encouraged, it is not required of patrons to use our public access computers. So, whether you're researching your family tree as a hobby or educational purposes, be sure to use these great FREE resources. 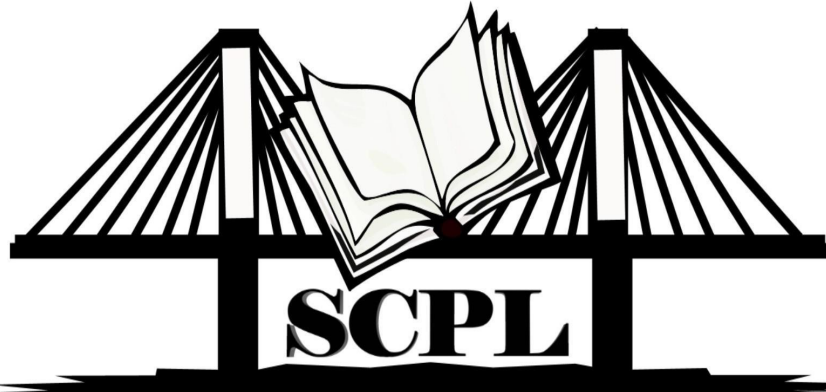
