Did you know that Spencer County Public Library offers several free services to the community besides access to books, movies, Internet, etc? SCPL currently employs one Notary Public at the Main Library—Rockport. Regular hours for this service are as follows: Monday-Tuesday & Thursday-Friday 8:00am—3:30pm. A notary public is a public officer of the state, authorized by law to certify documents, take affidavits, and administer oaths. Notarization is important as an attestation that the signature or signatures on a document have been witnessed, and the parties identified by an impartial public official.

SCPL also offers access to numerous periodical subscriptions. Each SCPL location offers different subscriptions but all locations receives The Evansville Courier & Press, The Spencer

County Journal, & Spencer County Leader. Other available subscriptions include: The Perry County News The Warrick County Standard, Messenger Enquirer, The Indianapolis Star, and The New York Times. SCPL also subscribes to several weekly/monthly magazine publications. We strive to provide something for everyone, including monthly craft magazines to sports illustrated and everything in-between. Each SCPL location offers a different variety of periodicals, so please visit a location near you to discover what is offered.

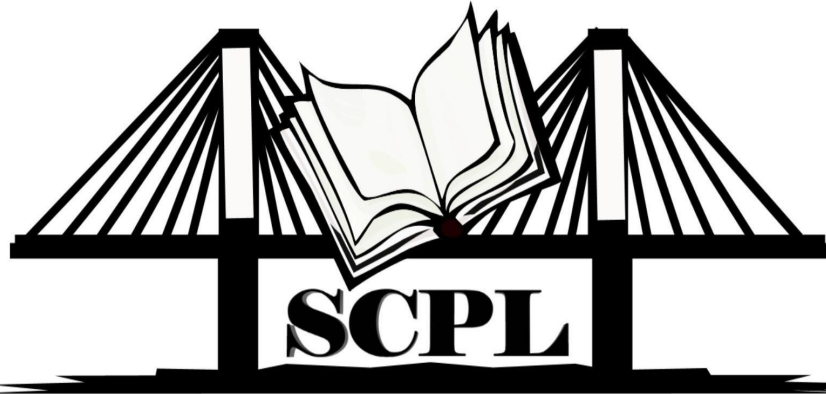
