SCPL has recently subscribed to two databases for language learning: Muzzy Club and LingoLite. Both databases are free and available to any SCPL card holder in good standing. These databases can be accessed directly from the library website, www.spencercountypubliclibrary.org. Hover over 'Quicklinks/Research' then click on 'Research & Databases,

Muzzy Club is a database geared toward youth to learn a second or third language. Offering nine (9) languages, Muzzy incorporates cartoons and games to learn another language. Languages available on Muzzy Club:

LingoLite helps you learn basic vocabulary in 30 languages. LingoLite offers patrons images, text, and native speaker videos so you can see and hear how the language looks and sounds. LingoLite is said to help you learn another language up to four

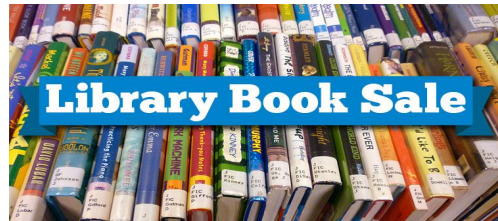

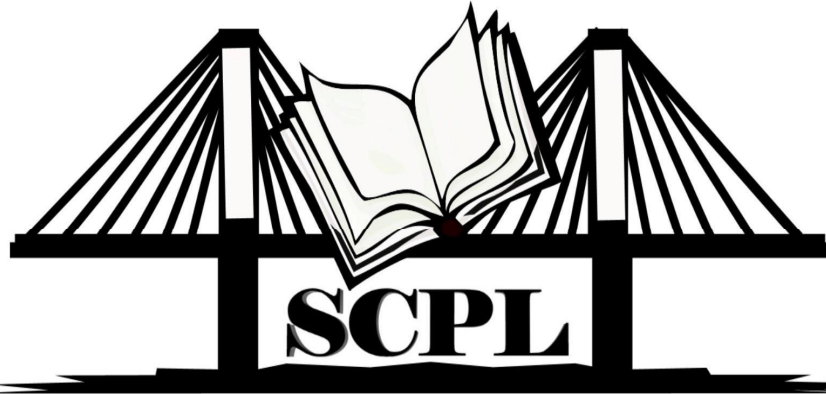
