Spencer County Public Library will celebrate National Teen Tech Week March 4-10. The national theme for 2018 is "Libraries are For Creating." This year's theme encourages teens to take advantage of all the great digital tools offered through the library to become content creators, and to leverage library resources to share their creations!

PLAYAWAY LAUNCHPADS

The newest addition to SCPL's circulating materials are Playaway Launchpads. Launchpads are pre-loaded tablets that require no downloads or Wi-Fi connection. The launchpads are pre-loaded with learning apps & games, comics and/or videos that can be accessed anytime, anywhere. The 7-inch high-definition touch screens are protected with a durable case and use an Android operating system. SCPL has recently purchased launchpads for ages 3-5 (grades Pre-K—K) and ages 5-7 (grades K-2). Check out these new launchpads in the children's department at the Main Library—Rockport. They circulate like a regular playaway or book, so you can check one out for three (3) weeks!




