LIBRARIES ROCK! SUMMER READING PROGRAM



Get ready to turn it all the way up on June 4, 2018 when Summer Programs kick off at SCPL!!! Libraries Rock! is the 2018 Summer Reading Program theme, and we'll be rockin' for seven weeks!

Programs, activities, and reading challenges are planned for ALL ages. Adults may select library materials of their choice—books, magazines, newspapers, audio books, and ebooks—to check out and read for entries in our prize drawings. Teens have a variety of ways to participate in summer programs: weekly activity programs, reading for points and prizes and completing activity sheets for rewards. Children and Tweens have the opportunity to attend fun and entertaining weekly programs and participate in the Reading program for points and prizes.

New this year is the opportunity for those kids ages 3–5th grade who cannot attend a weekly program to participate in the Summer Reading Program. SRP is a read-at-your-own-pace activity. Just pick up an official SRP reading log at any of our four locations to get started. Check out library materials, read, and mark the log as directed. Bring the reading log into any SCPL branch during open hours to claim your prizes!


