LIBRARY PROGRAMS: MORE THAN JUST STORYTIME

Did you know that SCPL offers programs for more than just children? In recent years SCPL has added new programs targeted towards adults (18 years+). Programs for adults are offered at all SCPL locations and vary in purpose. Some of our adult programs include:

- ◆ Book Clubs: a club organized for the discussion and reviewing of books; meets monthly; titles are chosen in advance and participants are expected to have read the material (but not required) before the monthly meeting
 - ◆ Rockport Book Club—1st Friday of the month at 1:00pm (Contact Erin, 812-649-4866, for more information)
 - ◆ Richland Book Club—2nd Monday of the month at 1:30pm (Contact Charlynn, 812-359-4146, for more information)
- ◆ Crafternoon: a program designed to promote crafts and activities for adults; occurs monthly (Contact Marilyn, 812-649-4866, for more information)
 - ◆ Main Library—Rockport: traditionally the 3rd Wednesday of the month at 1:00pm
 - ◆ Branch location: rotates between branches monthly
- ◆ Recipe Swap: a club organized for the tasting and sharing of recipes; occurs monthly, each month has a different theme that participants should try to follow
 - ◆ Marylee Vogel Branch—Richland: 1st Thursday of the month at 5:00pm (Contact Charlynn, 812-359-4146, for more information)
- ◆ Crochet Club: a club organized to teach and share crochet techniques & patterns; occurs monthly
 - ◆ Parker Branch—Hatfield: 2nd Thursday of the month at 3:00pm (Contact Shannon, 812-359-4030, for more information)


