Libby is a free app where you can borrow ebooks and digital audiobooks from your Library. You can stream books with Wi-Fi or mobile data, or download them for offline use to read anytime, anywhere. All you need to get started is a library card. This is a free service for our patrons and there are thousands of titles available to choose from. 
