The more you read, the more entries you may put into the prize drawing. Complete 2 items on a bookmark to earn an entry into the prize drawing. Complete as many bookmarks as you wish. Beanstack participants automatically get 1 entry for registering for this program. Digital content through Overdrive and Libby is included. All items should be checked out from a SCPL location. All 2020 Winter Reading Event bookmarks must be returned by Saturday, February 29th to be eligible to win.

You may track your progress using the bookmarks provided by the Library or through Beanstack. Beanstack is easy to use and available both online and as a mobile app. Get started by visiting the Spencer County Public Library website at <http://spencercountypubliclibrary.org/> and clicking on the Beanstack tab to create your account.



What is Beanstack?

Introducing our new online book discovery service for readers of all ages –Beanstack is a free online service that offers an innovative new way to connect children and their families with books and educational reading activities that match each person’s interests, ages and reading level. It also includes book and activity logging, badges and registration for all members of the family under one account. Available 24/7 through your computer or mobile device, Beanstack also uses the information you provide to send out great book and activity recommendations to each registrant on a regular basis. To make it even more useful, listed books are linked directly to the library’s catalog. And, be sure to take advantage of the various book reviews or write reviews of your latest reads!

How to Sign Up

Beanstack is easy to use and available both online and as a mobile app. Get started by visiting the Spencer County Public Library website at:

and clicking on the Beanstack tab to create your account.

You can also register through the app. Have your Library Card ready and choose how you would like to register (as an individual, registering a child, registering a family or group) and then complete all required fields (marked with *) in the online form. If you do not have a Library Card, visit your local branch to sign up today!

Note: An email address is required, if you do not have an email address you will need to create one first then come back to register for Beanstack. Once registered, you can access your account online or in the app by signing in with your username and password.
